PROCLAMATION

EO 20-36

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME - GREETINGS:

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO DECLARE AN END TO THE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED IN EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-29

WHEREAS: Executive Order 20-29, issued on June 2, 2020, declared a state of emergency pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 12-61-111 and Ark. Code Ann. § 12-61-115, for the purpose of activating the National Guard to assist the Arkansas State Police and other law enforcement in a unified command response for the protection of citizens and properties from violence and destruction; and

WHEREAS: That threat of violence and destruction to citizens and property no longer exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Arkansas do hereby declare that the State of Emergency as declared by Executive Order 20-29, on June 2, 2020, has ended. As a result, the call for a unified command response is no longer necessary and the National Guard is deactivated for the purposes of the referenced emergency.
