**PROCLAMATION**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Excellence in education and ethical values are vital to the success of our nation and our state. In the great state of Arkansas, we seek the betterment of our citizens and look to instill each child and adolescent with quality education and an understanding of good ethics; and

WHEREAS: By preparing our students for the responsibilities and opportunities of the future, education develops the intellect through lessons in literacy, math, and science; and

WHEREAS: The Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem Schneerson, a global spiritual leader who dedicated his life to the betterment of mankind, was a tireless advocate for youth around the world. He emphasized the importance of education and good character and instilled hope for a brighter future into the lives of countless people in America and across the globe; and

WHEREAS: The Rebbe taught that education should include the acquisition of knowledge and preparation for a career to make a better living for oneself as well as for the society as a whole, and that the educational system must therefore pay more attention to the building of character, with emphasis on moral and ethical values; and
